Key Responsibilities:

- Assist in maintaining SCCLF's digital and social media presence.
- Communicate with TealHaus and SCCLF to gather information for the creation of engaging content to share on SCCLF's social media and website.
- Support in preparing quarterly investor report newsletters by compiling project data, client success stories, and organization updates.
- Facilitate the development of SCCLF's annual impact report, including drafting stories, gathering and compiling feedback, and editing.
- Collaborate on marketing materials, including flyers, presentation decks, and other printed materials.
- Manage and organize communications files and shared photo libraries.
- Attend team meetings and provide input on marketing-related activities.
